Two are better than one, because they have a good reward for their toil. (Ecclesiastes 4:9)

I love this verse and the truth it contains for the believer's task of making disciples. It is true for believers who serve together with fellow church members as they strive together to share the Gospel through their church's ministry and mission outreach efforts. And it is true when churches work with other churches in their local communities, networks, associations, state conventions, and national conventions.

The recent Christmas Backpack collection is a great example of this. 663 backpacks from 20 NCBN churches, 4 neighboring association churches, and 1 church whose name was not recorded were taken from our collection site at Highland Baptist Church to the regional site at Cornerstone Baptist Church in Lexington. A recent FB report from the coordinator at that site said that 1546 backpacks had been collected and processed last week. There are 3 other regional sites and many other churches (some NCBN) have also transported their backpacks directly to a ministry site in eastern Kentucky or the Cincinnati area. All these churches will see a "good reward for their toil" as many children and families will receive the physical blessing of the backpack and its contents and the spiritual blessing of having the love of God and the Gospel of Christ shared with them.

Another way that our NCBN churches are working together for the sake of making disciples can be found in the scholarships that we offer. The Luis and Raquel Salazar Memorial Trust for International Missions provides partial scholarships to Network

church members who are going on international mission trips. The John and Paul Barnett Fund for Missions awards partial scholarships for



those going on domestic mission trips. It provides opportunities churches to receive mission start-up grants or emergency church relief grants. And we have the Dr. Larry Orange Equipping the Called Scholarship which gives scholarships to church pastors and staff who are working on seminary or Bible college degrees. Through these scholarships, our Network churches find that "two are better than one" as they work together to support those who are engaged in the tasks of missions and disciple -making.

Please note, now is the time to begin filling out applications for these scholarships. The application deadline is April 15 for anyone seeking a partial international (Salazar) or domestic (Barnett) mission trip scholarship for the summer of 2024. April 15 is also the deadline for the Calling Out the Called scholarship for church pastors or staff members who will be students at SBTS, Boyce, or Clear Creek in the fall of 2024. These applications can be downloaded at www.ncbnetwork.org/scholarships.






