Early Reflections: Freedom from Fear

Psalms 53:4-6 says, "Whenever I am afraid, I will trust in you.

In God

(I will praise His Word), in God I have put my trust: I will not fear.

What can flesh do to me?

I recently had a friend share a story with me about fear. He told me of an instance when his adult daughter was called on with short notice to be a substitute teacher for a Sunday school class at her church. As she traveled to church with her family, she shared with her husband about her fears of being unprepared for the assignment. Her five year old daughter entered the conversation from the back seat with a question. She asked, "Is fear the same thing as being scared?" Her mother replied, "Why yes it is," The little girl then said to her mother, "Well....fear is a liar."

This little girl knows what she is talking about! On the same day on the way to work, at the parsonage, I heard the new song, "Fear is a Liar". I said yes Lord I get it. God has not given His children a "spirit of fear" (2 Timothy 1:7) He has given us the promise of His presence as we trust Him and live above the power of fear. He is worthy of our trust.
